Must have a breast health concern (lump, pain discharge)
Must not have breast implants
Must be low income
Must have income equal or less than 250% above the Federal Poverty Guidelines
Must be uninsured or underinsured (Provide Proof)
Must live in one of the following counties: Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Erath, Grayson, Hood, Hunt, Johnson, Kaufman, Navarro, Palo Pinto, Parker, Rockwall, Somervell, and Tarrant
Cancer must be stage 3 or less and no metastasis outside of the breast region.

Bright Pink

- Focuses on young women who are at high risk for breast/ovarian cancer based upon a family history, genetic predisposition, or previous cancer diagnosis.
- Offers Experiential Outreach Groups which are support groups that take place in the context of a fun activity (such as a yoga class, wine & cheese tasting or pottery painting) and are followed by an organized and facilitated discussion on a topic that is related to being young and at high risk for or developing breast/ovarian cancer.
